Purpose: To provide a one-time \$500 scholarship and a one-time \$250 scholarship to

two (2) eligible Speech and Debate members towards their postsecondary education.

Award: Two (2) scholarships will be awarded to two (2) different students by the

McClintock High School Masque and Gavel Scholarship Committee. The award will be

sent to the attending school after proof of admission is established. A student may apply

to both Masque and Gavel Scholarships, but will only be awarded one (1) scholarship.

Eligibility:

- 1. A senior graduating in the class of 2024.
- 2. A minimum GPA of 2.5. (An unofficial or official transcript required.)
- 3. Participation in Winter Trophy and State in the 2023-2024 academic year.
